



The Core Competencies are front and centre. Teachers can attach any of the competencies to a learning sample, encouraging students to self reflect on them on the spot.

Subject areas can be tagged to any learning sample. Then, by filtering by subject area, it ensures there are examples of learning in context across all the curriculum. Don't forget, in most classrooms, a project often encompasses more than one subject area, so tag it to as many areas as you like!

Title:

Learning Intention/Description of Learning Activity:

In this area, the teacher will share the intentions of the lesson. They may include direct references to core or curricular competencies, and will list criteria and frame the expectations of the lesson.

When you look in your child's digital portfolio, you might see written work, but you will also see photos of students engaged in learning, video recordings of presentations or learning tasks, and audio recordings of reading fluency and story telling.

Teacher Comments/Feedback:

This is where the teacher will make comments on how the student is working towards the goals of the lesson. Sometimes, comments may be left part way through the project with reflections on progress so far, and other times the teacher will comment at the end of the project. Comments will connect the criteria with the student's work, and how they addressed the expectations of the assignment.

Next Steps:

This is a message from the teacher to the student indicating goals and thoughts about areas of strength and areas that the student could focus on next time.
